HOME BREW & CHILL 2021 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Home Brew and Chill registration form **MUST** be filled out online at <https://www.greensburgcraft-beerweek.com/homebrewers/> Only brewers who are registered and approved will be able to set up.
- Competition is open to any style home brewer.
- Participation will be limited. **Signups close once limit is reached.**
- There is no fee to register and compete.
- An entrant may not be a Co-Brewer if they have already submitted entries as the main brewer.
- Homebrew means home. Your homebrew must not be brewed at a place that brews beverages for commercial purposes, whether for commercial research, production or any other purpose, including brewpubs and other brew-on- premise establishments or is brewed for commercial sale. You must give the name of any and all individuals who helped in the brewing process under “Co-brewer” on your entry form.
- Only ONE submission per home brewer will be judged during BJCB blind tasting.
- Up to TWO submissions per home brewer will be allowed for People’s Choice. You may have attendees taste other brews but they are only allowed to vote for submitted beers.
- Beer names, styles and information will be confirmed 1 week before the event via email. Beers **cannot** be changed for BJCP judging after that day.

- We are capping the event at 430 attendees including sold and donated tickets.
- Please make sure to have 5-10 gallons of beer.
- All brewers will have a specific area to set up. GBGCBW will provide tables and spray bottles.
- Tasting glasses and cups for attendees will be provided by GBGCBW.
- Ice will be provided by GBGCBW
- Must provide a way to serve your own beer. Home brewers will need to bring your own keg tubs and/or bottle/can coolers.
