# HOME BREW & CHILL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Home Brew and Chill registration form MUST be filled out online at https://www.greensburgcraftbeerweek.com/homebrewers/ Only brewers who are registered and approved will be able to set up.
- Competition is open to any style home brewer.
- Participation will be limited. Signups close once limit is reached.
- There is no fee to register and compete.
- An entrant may not be a Co-Brewer if they have already submitted entries as the main brewer.
- Homebrew means home. Your homebrew must not be brewed at a place that brews beverages for commercial purposes, whether for commercial research, production or any other purpose, including brewpubs and other brew-on- premise establishments or is brewed for commercial sale. You must give the name of any and all individuals who helped in the brewing process under "Co-brewer" on your entry form.
- Only ONE submission per home brewer will be judged during BJCB blind tasting.
- Up to TWO submissions per home brewer will be allowed for People's Choice. You may have attendees taste other brews but they are only allowed to vote for submitted beers.
- Beer names, styles and information must be submitted and confirmed 1 week before the event via email. Beers cannot be changed for BJCP judging after that day.

## Judging:

#### Best in Show:

- This will be a BJCP sanctioned event, the competition will be judged by BJCP guidelines. You can find a downloadable version Program Style Guidelines & descriptions at https://www.bjcp.org/bjcp-style-guidelines/
- All beers for BJCP judging must be bottled and labeled with the provided label (label file will be emailed the week of the event.)
- 2 bottles must be submitted.
- All bottles must be submitted the day of the event to the submission table in person, please don't leave bottles, by 12:00pm.

#### People's Choice:

All submissions will be voted on by tickets given to attendees to vote for their favorite home brew. The beer with the highest votes will be awarded the winner. GBGCBW will provide tickets for voting and containers/bags pre labeled for People's Choice beers for breweries.

### Day of Event Information:

- All brewers must be set up by 12:30pm. Event starts at 1pm sharp.
- We are capping the event at 350 attendees including sold and donated tickets.
- Please make sure to have 5-10 gallons of beer.
- Please have signage for your beers/brewery.
- All brewers will have a specific area to set up.
- Tasting glasses and cups for attendees will be provided by GBGCBW.
- Ice will be provided by GBGCBW
- Must provide a way to serve your own beer. Home brewers will need to bring your own keg tubs and/ or bottle/can coolers.
- Anyone not listed on the form submitted as a co-brewer must purchase a ticket to the event. No exceptions.
- All brewers must be 21+
